# The Statistics of the Bible

**Abstract:** By inspiration, I read the bible three times. The first reading gives birth to the idea, the second defines the objective while the third actualizes the objective which is this write-up called the Statistics of the Bible. The scope covers the number of books 78 (51 old testament, 27 new testament), the chapters 1345 (1085 old, 260 new), the verses 36095 (28139 old, 7956 new) and average verse 27 (26 old, 31 new). By way of upgrade, the number of words may be included in subsequent edition of this version. However, the numbers of words vary according to the bible version.

#### Introduction

I read the bible three times. The first reading was in no particular order. I read two chapters daily in the second approach. The third time, I read a chapter daily. I started on the fourth of March 2017 (Saturday) with the Old Testament and ended on twenty second of February 2020 (Saturday). I continued with the New Testament on the twenty third of February 2020 (Sunday) and ended on the eighth of November 2020 (Sunday). It therefore took me 1085 days and 260 days to complete the reading of the Old and New Testaments of the bible respectively. In other words, the Old Testament consists of 1085 chapters while the New Testament contains 260 chapters. The Old Testament comprises 51 books which includes 39 Ordinary Books (925 Chapters) and 12 Deuterocanonical Books (160 Chapters). The Deuterocanonical books range from Tobit to 2<sup>nd</sup> Maccabees on Table 1. The New Testament on the other hand consists of 27 books (260 Chapters). It was during the third reading that record was created for the development of the Statistics of the Bible. The objective of the write-up therefore is to present statistics containing the books, chapters and verses of the Bible.

#### Methodology

In the third approach 1 started keeping records of the Chapters and Verses of all the books of the Bible (51

books of the Old Testament and 27 books of the New Testament). Typical records are presented as follows.

#### Result

Table 1 and Table 2 are statistics for the Old and New Testaments of the bible respectively. Column 2 shows the books. Columns 3 and 4 show the chapters and total chapters respectively while Columns 5 and 6 indicate the verses and total verses respectively. Column 7 represents the average verse.




Figure 1: Plot of Old Testament Books and Total Chapters.




Figure 2: Plot of New Testament Books and Total Chapters.




Figure 3: Plot of Old Testament Books and Total Verses




Figure 4: Plot of New Testament Books and Total Verses.

### Interpretation

Total chapters indicate the cumulative number of chapters up to a particular book. For instance, the total chapters up to the book of Exodus is 90 consisting of 50 chapters for the book of Genesis and 40 chapters for the book of Exodus. Similarly, total verses up to the book of Exodus is 2715 comprising 1492 verses for the book of Genesis and 1223 verses for the book of Exodus. The average verse gives the quotient of the total verses and the total chapters. For example, the average verse of 30.58 up to the book of Exodus is the division of 2715 by 90 (the total verses and total chapters respectively up to the book of Exodus).

## Discussion

As mentioned earlier, the Old Testament contains 51 books consisting of 39 Ordinary books of 925 chapters, 23337 verses and 12 Deuterocanonical books of 160 chapters, 4802 verses. The New Testament comprises 27 books of 260 chapters and 7956 verses. (Good News Bible, 1979). There are three synoptic gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke and the gospel of John. The four gospels contain 89 chapters and 3778 verses. Most of the books of the New Testament are written by St. Paul except the Gospels, Acts, James, 1st and 2nd Peter, 1st 2nd 3rd John, Jude and Revelation. Even Hebrews is written in the style of St. Paul. The other 23 books of the New Testament, excluding the 4 Gospels, contain 171 chapters and 4178 verses. Of 51 books, 1085 chapters and 28139 verses of the Old Testament, the average number of verses is about 26 (25.93). The New Testament with 27 books, 260 chapters and

7956 verses has about 31 (30.60) as average number of verses. The bible contains 78 books, 1345 chapters, 36095 verses and 27 (26.84) average verses. Figures 1 and 2 are graphical presentations of the books and total chapters of the old and new testaments respectively. Similarly, figures 3 and 4 indicate the plot of books and total verses of the old and new testaments respectively. Notice that every book of the old testament is not reflected on the plots due to space. However, the total(cumulative) values of the chapters and verses are not affected by the omission on the plots.

# Conclusion

I read the bible three times. God the Father gives me the inspiration in the first approach. God the Son, creates the path in the second reading because Jesus is the Way, the Truth and the Light. God the Holy Spirit perfects it in the third approach. Hence the formation and presentation of the Statistics of the Bible. Glory be to the father, to the Son and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end Amen. The bible comprises 78 books (51 Old and 27 New Testaments), 1345 chapters (1085 Old and 260 New Testaments), 36095 verses (28139 Old and 7956 New Testaments) and 27 average verses (26 Old and 31 New Testaments).
